Fees are due in full by Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> January 2019, any fees received after this date will be subject to a **£5.00 surcharge per cat**.

All fees MUST be paid with entry – no fees on the day please.

**All fees are non refundable after the closing date.**

**Overseas Exhibitors** – can pay in Euros on the day of the show by arrangement, or transfer the GBP fees as above direct to our bank account (details below)

**Entry Fees** (1 adult free per pen) - Adult: £2.00, Child: £1.00

**Catalogue** (1 free per exhibitor) - £3.00

### Qualifications – note that entry to this show is subject to the following qualification:

The exhibitor must be a **full member of a Felis Britannica Club** or an **associate member of a Felis Britannica Club** and a **full member of another FIFe Club**; the Club shall verify the qualification.

The show is only open to cats achieving one or more of the following qualifications:

- **Adults** - Best in Variety, or Nomination for Best in Show within the preceding 12 month period, or any cat with the title IC/IP or higher
- **Juniors** - EX1 in classes 11/12
- **Kittens** - Any kitten 4-7 months shown in Class 12 at the Winners show is not required to qualify
- **Domestic Cats/ New Varieties/ Unrecognised Breeds** - Best in Variety or Nomination for Best in Show Pet/ New Variety/ Unrecognised Breed

The title “National Winner (NW)” will be awarded to those cats winning Best in Category at the Annual Felis Britannica Winners Show, provided that they have competed against at least 10 cats to achieve this title and are owned by a Full UK member of a Felis Britannica Club. In the event that any Best in Category Winner is owned by a non member of a Felis Britannica Club, the title will be awarded to the next highest placed cat in the category owned by a Felis Britannica full member, provided the required number of cats have been competed against.

## White cats

No white cat can be accepted at a FIFe show without a Certificate of Full Hearing. This will need to be produced during the vetting-in process

## Vaccinations

All cats must be inoculated against Feline Infectious Enteritis, FVR and FCV. The full course in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation must have been completed ***at least 15 days prior to the show.*** You will be required to produce a current vaccination certificate for each cat exhibited

**Amendments:** are free of charge up to the closing date; after this date there is a surcharge of £5.00 per cat

**Late Entries:** may be accepted at the discretion of the show manager for a surcharge of £5.00; **if the hall capacity has not been reached**

**Cat Names / Numbers:** The full registered name and number (exactly as it is stated on the registration document, including any registration letter and / or titles and awards) must also be stated on the show entry form. Awards and titles gained at the show are dependant on the correct information being available to the Show Manager

**Confirmation:** It is the Exhibitors responsibility to ensure that an entry has been accepted. An SAE enclosed with the entry is recommended. If you provide an email address confirmation will be sent by the Saturday before the show.

### Vetting In:

Strictly 7.30 am – 8.30 am. Cats must be in their pens by 9.00 am

**Show Classes:** The Show Manager will enter your cat in the appropriate class according to information received. **It is the Exhibitors responsibility to check their cat's details in the catalogue and if a mistake is found, inform the Secretariat before the judging commences, after which point it will be too late.**

**Colour Assessments:** Please ensure that you have requested a colour assessment with your entry, or as soon as possible after this as we may not be able to accommodate a request on the day

**Stewarding:** Exhibitors will be asked to present their own cats to the judge, however help will be on hand if required.

For Best in Show only Stewards are allowed to present cats.

Applications to steward are welcome and should be addressed to the show manager.
