Registrations, Title Validations and Club Membership

Under FIFe rules any cat shown in class 7 or 8 or higher must be registered with FIFe and any titles achieved at Felis Britannica shows must be validated through your Club within a month. To be eligible for the annual FB points awards your cat must be registered with FIFe. To enter cats for the FB Winners show you must be a member of a Felis Britannica club.

Colour Assessments

If your cat requires a colour assessment, please book this at the time of entry. If you are at all unsure of the colour or if the correct EMS code has been used, then use this facility – corrections cannot be made once judging has started and incorrectly coloured exhibits will be disqualified. There is a charge of £5.00

Rosettes

Certificates, awards or rosettes will be given for nominations, Side Classes, Best In Variety, Best in Show and Best of the Best. You will receive a certificate and critique on the day for your class placing.

White Cats

No white cats can be accepted at a FFe show without a Certificate of Hearing. This will need to be produced during the vetting in process.

Vaccinations

All cats must be inoculated against Feline Parvo-virus (Feline Infectious Peritonitis, FIE), FVR & FCV. The full course in accordance with manufacturer's recommendation must have been completed at least **15 days prior to the show**. You will be required to produce a current vaccination certificate for each cat in attendance.

Theme & Decorated Pens- not mandatory

The theme of this show is "**Tapestry, Tweed & Tartan**". We hope you will join us in dressing up and decorating your pens. There will be a prize for the best decorated pen, judged on Saturday. Alternatively show drapes or GCCF whites are perfectly acceptable.

Amendments & Late Entries

Free of charge up to the closing date; after which there is a surcharge of £5 for amendments and £10 for late entries, issued solely at the discretion of the Show Manager

Cat Names

The full registered name (exactly as it is stated on the registration document, including any registration letter and/or titles and awards) must also be stated on the show entry form. Awards and titles gained at the show are dependent on the correct information being available to the entry clerk.

Confirmation

Confirmation of entry will be sent to exhibitors once their entry has been processed. This will be by e-mail (if given) or post (if SAE provided).

Show Classes

The entry clerk will enter your cat in the appropriate class according to information received. **It is the exhibitor's responsibility** to check their cats' details in the catalogue and if a mistake is found, inform the Secretariat before judging commences, after which point it will be too late.

Stewarding

Exhibitors will be asked to present their own cats to the judge; however, help will be on hand if required. For Best in Show, only stewards are allowed to present cats.

Catering
